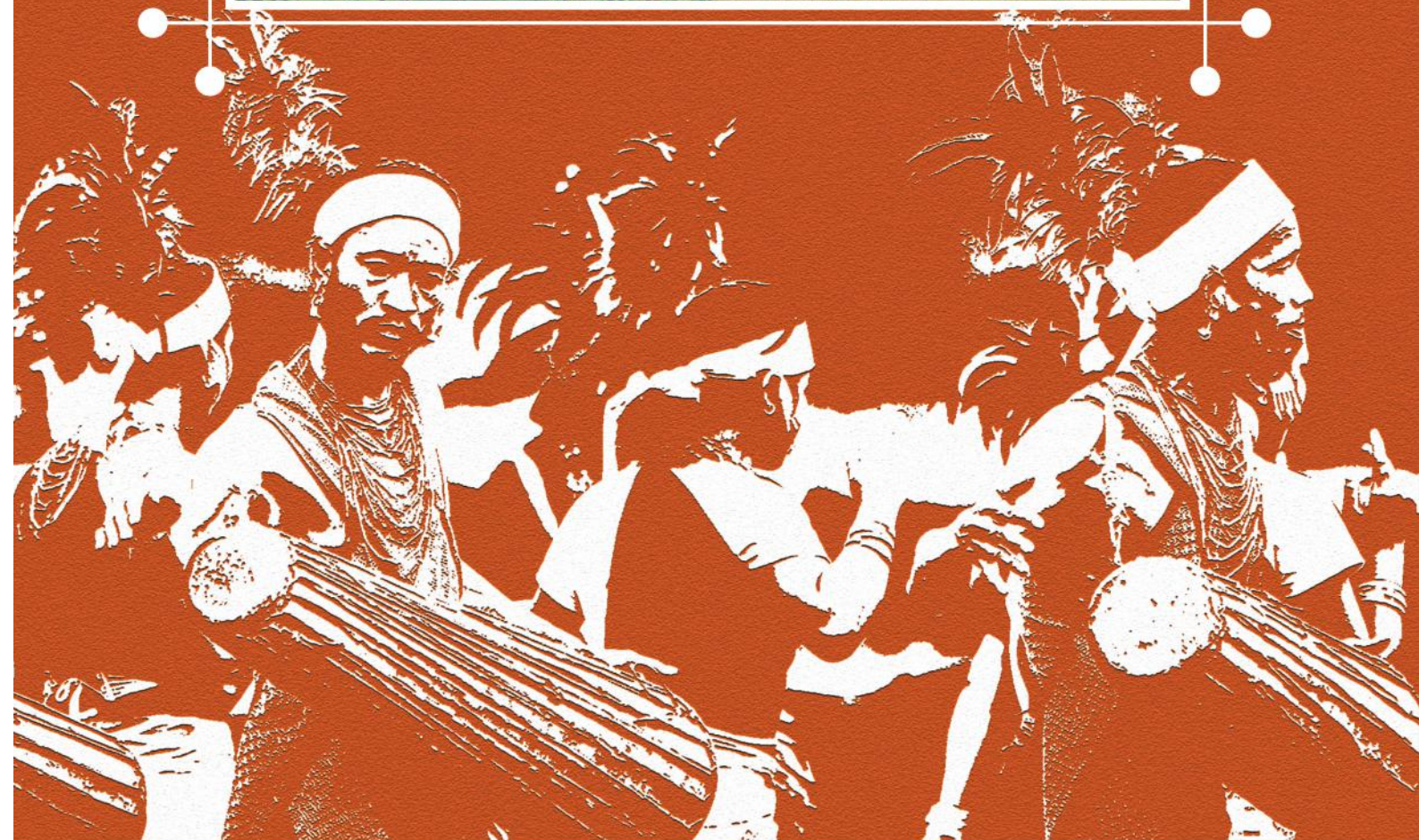
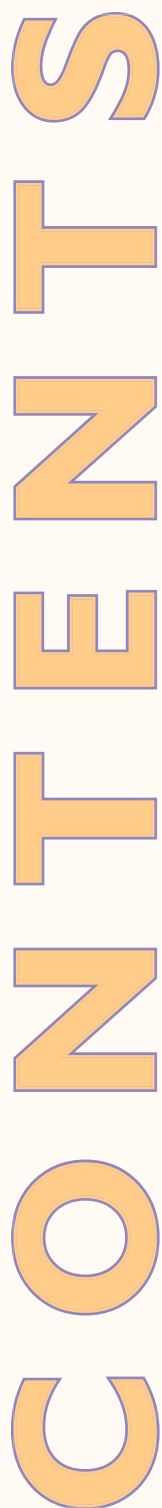


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Message from the Vice Chancellor

It is my privilege to present the Eighteenth Annual Report of the ICFAI University Meghalaya for the year 2023-24. In compliance with Section 44 of the ICFAI University Meghalaya Act 2005 [Meghalaya Act No. 12 of 2005], a report on the academic operations and activities for the period 1st Apr. 2023 to 31st Mar. 2024 is here by appended.

Further, in the year 2023-24, the University started a new Post Graduate Program in the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, namely, Master of Arts in Music. The Program has been implemented under the UGC's Choice Based Credit System.

It has always been my goal as the University's Vice Chancellor to create a culture of professionalism, openness, and responsibility while providing the student body with exceptional service. 1. Introduction

The ICFAI University Meghalaya (formerly known as the Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts University, Meghalaya) was established under the provisions of the Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts of India University Act, 2005 (Meghalaya Act No. 12 of 2005) vide Notification No. EDN. 261/2004/124 dated 22.02.2006 of the Government of Meghalaya, (amended by State Legislature vide Act No.6 of 2021). The University is sponsored by the ICFAI Society, a not-for-profit Educational Society established in 1984 under the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) Public Societies Registration Act, 1350F.

- ▶ The ICFAI University Meghalaya is located at Tura, West Garo Hills District, Meghalaya. The University believes in creating and disseminating knowledge and skills in core and frontier areas through innovative educational Programs, research, consulting and publishing and developing a cadre of professionals with a high level of competence and deep sense of ethics and commitment to the code of professional conduct.

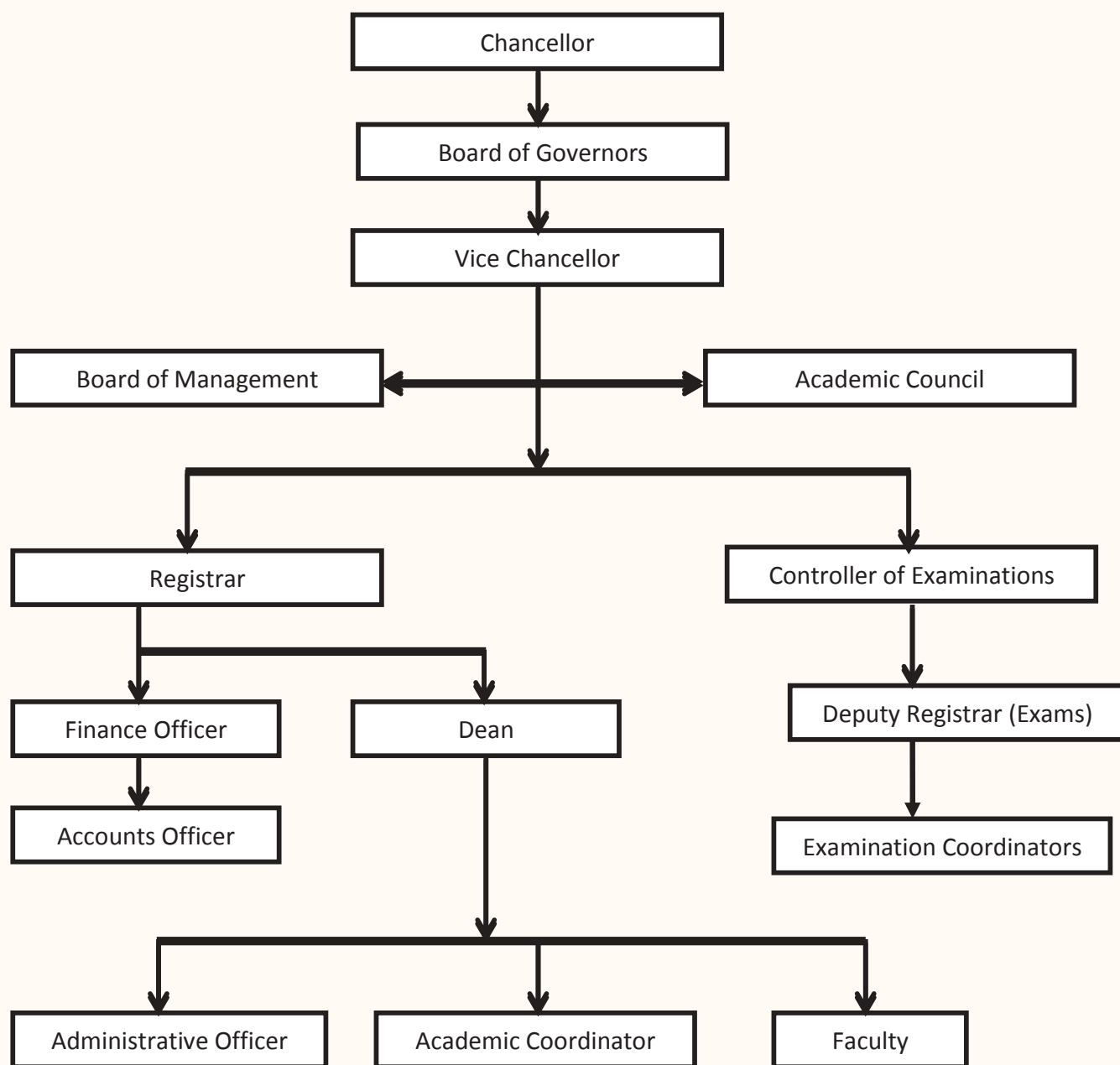

9. Infrastructure

The University is endowed with excellent facilities required for creating a congenial academic atmosphere. State-of-the-art infrastructure is available at the ICFAI University, Meghalaya to meet the requirements of the programs conducted.

A. Academic Complex:

The University Campus at Tura spreads across 13.5 acres of land. The Academic and Administrative building stands on a built up area of 40,156 sq.ft. It has a state-of-the-art infrastructure with all amenities required for quality education.

The Shillong Campus is housed in a rented building at Dhankheti, in the hub of the city. It has similar amenities as the Campus at Tura. Shillong being the educational hub for North East, the University is on the lookout for a suitable site in and around Shillong.

Both the Campuses have well-stocked libraries augmented with periodicals and journals comprising of ICFAI Publications and others. The Campuses are also well-equipped with Computer labs.

B. Library Facilities:

C. Lab Facilities:

- **Computer Lab:** The PC Lab is prepared with cutting-edge Intel-based computing facility at each of the Campuses. The computer systems are linked through Local Area Network (LAN) in hybrid style with sufficient net bandwidth for standard use, specifically for on-line training, research, video conferencing, etc..
- **Hospitality Lab:** The hospitality lab is geared up with gadgets that are required for Food and Beverage Services, Housekeeping and Front Office education for the scholars to assist them in getting a realistic education which to cater to their needs.

Other Infrastructure

- **Health Centre:** First Aid facilities are available.
- **Placement Cell:** The Placement Cell, comprising of the Faculty Members, takes care of the Placement requirements of the Students and helps in facilitating Campus recruitment drives.
- **Internship Cell:** The Internship Cell of the University, headed by the Faculty Members, takes care of the Internships and Dissertations that are undertaken by the students as part of their curriculum and Industry interface of the University.

Selection and Admission Process

Selection of applications into respective programs is made through screening of applications and personal interviews.

Postgraduate Programs

MBA Program:

The Master in Business Administration (MBA) program provides the students with the knowledge, skills and strategic perspectives essential to business leadership and managerial career. The curriculum is designed to provide a portfolio of strong functional skills and the ability to adapt and integrate these skills in different management settings.

Students who have graduated in any discipline from a recognized University with an aggregate of 45% marks and above are eligible to apply for the same.

MTTM Program:

This program initially was known as the Master in Tourism Administration (MTA). However, in compliance with UGC directive, the program is renamed as Master in Travel and Tourism Management (MTTM). The MTTM program prepares students for managerial positions as required by the tourism industry, which is one of the fastest growing industries in the world. The program equips the students with entrepreneurship skills in the field of tourism administration.

Students who have graduated in any discipline from a recognized University with an aggregate of 45% marks and above are eligible to apply for the Program.

M.Com Program:

The master in Commerce (M.Com) program is a postgraduate program covering areas on accounting, management, banking and economics related courses. The uniqueness of this program is that, it allies with other Management courses making the student with this M.Com degree a multi-tasker.

Students who have graduated in Commerce, Economics (Hons.) and Business Management from a recognized University with an aggregate of 45% marks and above are eligible to apply for the Program.

MCA Program:

The Master of Computer Application (MCA) program is based on contemporary curriculum and cutting edge pedagogy thereby equipping the students with up-to-date technical and IT skills required in public and private sectors.

Students who have graduated in any discipline from a recognized University with an aggregate of 45% marks and above with Mathematics at the 10+2 level are eligible to apply for the Program.

M.A. (Education):

The Master of Arts in Education (M.A. Education) program is designed to prepare the students to understand, learn and practically apply the basic tenets of Education as a discipline of study. The program will help deliver skills and strategies for learning, from the sociological to the philosophical and psychological pillars of education. This program is prepared in a way to understand how we learn, what we learn, and how we transform that learning into action. The range of issues in education is vast. Hence, it will provide opportunities to explore topics with an in depth analysis. MA (Education) will give access to a wide range of learning experiences to hone the abilities and enable one to engage positively in any context.

The eligibility to seek admission into this program is a graduation in BA in Education (Honours) with an aggregate of 45%.

M.A. (English):

The Master of Arts in English (M.A. English) program is designed to prepare the students to understand and appreciate the English language and literature thoroughly and at the same time effectively use the language to enhance their Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing skills. The program seeks to offer the students a plethora of diverse topics covering almost each and every aspect of English language and literature. This will give a unique opportunity to the students to have a theoretical,

philosophical and analytical view of English language and literature.

The eligibility to seek admission into this program is a graduation in BA in English (Honours) with an aggregate of 50%.

M.A. (Political Science):

The Master of Arts in Political Science (M.A. Political Science) aims at promoting knowledge to the students based on basic theories, theoretical and conceptual framework of the discipline of Political Science. In consultation with the wide existing syllabi of different Universities, certain traditional and contemporary courses have been incorporated with detailed reading and Supplementary Reading lists to acquaint the students with such available source materials for necessary consultation from time to time, and further reading to prepare themselves not only for Post Graduate examinations but also for other competitive examinations in the near future.

The eligibility to seek admission into this program is a graduation in BA in Political Science (Honours) with an aggregate of 45%.

M.A. (Garo):

The Master of Arts in Garo (M.A. Garo) program was started in order to meet the growing demands of the students of Meghalaya, Assam and other parts of the North- East India for pursuing their post graduate studies and research. Keeping this in mind, the syllabus has been prepared based on the latest books written by local and non- local writers on the various aspects of Garo Literature and Language. The syllabus has also been framed to maintain the standard at par with the syllabi of other communities in other universities of North – East India. Importance has also been given to the studies of other Indian and English Literatures that are relevant to the courses.

The eligibility to seek admission into this program is a graduation in B.A. in Garo (Honours) with an aggregate of 45% or B.A. (Pass) with Garo as a Pass Course, with not less than 50% in aggregate in the said paper.

M.A. (Khasi):

The Master of Arts in Khasi program is designed to prepare the students to understand and appreciate the Khasi language and literature thoroughly and at the same time effectively use their Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing skills. The program seeks to offer the students a plethora of diverse topics covering almost each and every aspect of Khasi culture, polity, language and literature. This will give a unique opportunity to the students to have a theoretical, philosophical and analytical view of Khasi culture, polity, language and literature.

The eligibility to seek admission into this program is a Bachelor's degree in Khasi from a recognized university with an aggregate of 45%.

MSW:

The Master of Social Work program applies at the higher level the foundation knowledge, skills, values and ethics of social work practice in the assessment and treatment of individuals, families, groups, organizations, and communities. The program caters to develop a professional identity as a social worker by applying professional values and ethics to social work practice. The program demonstrates an understanding and appreciation for human diversity, to engage in non-discriminatory culturally sensitive practice that seeks social and economic justice for clients, without regard to age, class, caste, culture, disability, ethnicity, family structure, gender, marital status, national origin, race, religion, and sexual orientation. The program aims to use appropriate supervision and consultation to conduct research and disseminate research findings that contribute to enhancement of students' personal and professional development.

The eligibility to seek admission into this program is a Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university with an aggregate of 45%.

M.A. (Music):

The Master of Arts in Music is a 2-year postgraduate degree program that deals with the study of music. The course offers both theoretical and practical aspects of the study. It covers everything from understanding the origin, history to the form of music practiced in present times. There are people who are passionate about music and who want to take up music professionally in the future. MA in Music offers them a degree-based education in education that can help them set up a career in various areas of music. This is mainly a specialization course for those aspiring to study the theory and roots of music and also practicing music for its value.

The eligibility to seek admission into this program is a Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university with an aggregate of 45%.





Under Graduate Programs:

BBA Program:

The Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA) program imparts an in-depth knowledge and broad understanding of functional areas of Management. The program focuses on various areas of management and prepares the students for a professional career in management and readies them for pursuing an MBA degree after graduation.

BTTM Program:

The Bachelor in Travel and Tourism Management (BTTM) program prepares the students for managerial positions required by the tourism industry. The program envisages the students as entrepreneurs who want to start their business in the field of tourism and /or hospitality sectors.

B.Com. Program:

Commerce is the corner stone of the individual, the national and the global life, without which no economic activity can take place. The Bachelor of Commerce Program of the University opens a wide range of area for the students who want to make a mark for themselves in the public and private sectors. The program will help them to gain sufficient knowledge and skills in the field of economics and management which are the core essentials of the commercial world.

B.A. Economics (Hons) Program:

The Bachelor in Arts Economics (Hons) aims to meet the requirements of the dynamic world and equip students with the requisite knowledge giving them an edge in the current scenario and open up avenues to pursue varied career options. With this in mind, the core courses of Economics are supplemented by Management related courses.

B.A. Education (Hons) Program:

The Bachelor in Arts Education (Hons) program is designed to prepare the students to understand, learn and practically apply the basic tenets of Education as a discipline of study. The program will help deliver skills and strategies for learning, from the sociological to the philosophical and psychological pillars of education. This program is prepared in a way to understand how we learn, what we learn, and how we transform that

learning into action. The range of issues in education is vast. Hence, it will provide opportunities to explore topics with an in depth analysis. B.A. Education (Hons) will give access to a wide range of learning experiences to hone the abilities and enable one to engage positively in any context.

B.A. English (Hons) Program:

B.A. Political Science (Hons) Program:

The Bachelor in Arts Political Science (Hons) attempts to study and understand world events, their background, and the hows and whys of decisions being made that affect the people in totality. The program is designed to explain and understand the political system and politics from local to global levels. Importantly, graduates of Political Science honours are prepared for careers in government sectors, in international organizations such as the UNO, business, law, journalism, psychology to name a few.

BCA Program:

Bachelor in Computer Applications (BCA) program provides a sound academic base in computer skills and applications from which an advanced career in computer applications can be developed. The students get a good conceptual grounding in computer usage and its practical business applications.

Eligibility for Under Graduate Programs:

Students who have passed 10+2 in any stream from a recognized Board with an aggregate of 40% marks and above are eligible to apply for the Program.

12. Implementation of National Education Policy 2020

The National Education Policy-2020 (NEP-2020) was announced by the Government of India in July 2020. The NEP 2020 covers all levels of education from school to higher education as well as professional and adult education. The NEP 2020 posits itself on the doctrines of affordability, accessibility, quality, equity, and accountability.

The ICFAI University Meghalaya has implemented the NEP 2020 in all its Undergraduate Programs in the Faculty of Management Studies, the Faculty of Science and Technology and the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences from the Academic Year 2023-2024 onwards.

In framing the Course Structure for the Curricula of the Undergraduate Programs under NEP 2020, the University has abided by the following guidelines as provided in the University Grants Commission (UGC) Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programs.

17. Student Activities
